Our new Neighborhood Watch sign at Hartsfield entrance should be installed within two weeks. We will be adding "NO SOLICITING" and "COMMUNITY GOVERNED BY COVENANTS AND RESTRICTIONS" to signs as well. Solicitors continue to ignore signs and claim they have a permit from the HOA. Please be assured they do NOT nor will they ever!! The permit they might have is one required and issued by COJ.

I'm sure everyone has noticed the beautiful landscape at the Ft. Caroline entrance. Andy, Owner of The Plant Place Nursery, did a wonderful job renewing our entrance island, including cutting down the out of control pittosporum which hides our irrigation controls. Andy will also be working to beautify the Hartsfield entrance as the freeze took its toll on the vast majority of plantings.
